DOCTRINE OF FAITHFULNESS

- I. God alone is totally faithful to the believer, (immutability).
- II. God is faithful to the believer in Rebound, 1Jn.1:9. He applies Jesus Christ's death to the sin each time. He forgives every time.
- III. God is faithful to His plan in spite of mankind, time, or geographical location, 1Cor.1:9.
- IV. God is faithful in saving grace, living grace, maturity, dying grace, and surpassing grace (SG₃), 1Thess.5:24.
- V. God is faithful in testing.
 - A. Living grace testing.
 - B. Testing in maturity, Gen.22; 1Cor.10:13.
- VI. God is faithful to the Royal Family to provide our SG₃, Heb.10:23.
- VII. God is faithful to the reversionistic believer, 2Tim.2:13.
- VIII. God is faithful to the believer in the Angelic Conflict, 2Thess.3:3.
 - IX. God's faithfulness is especially evident to the mature believer, Heb.11:11.
 - X. Faithfulness is the divine expression of immutability through grace. It is a result of His character and essence.
 - XI. Faithfulness is the consistence and stability of God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit.
